The traditional Dutch Jan Klaassen and Katrijn characters, the English Mr Punch, and the Hungarian Vitéz László.

The Neapolitan Pulcinella and the French Guignol from Lyon.

Rod marionette theatre from Sicily and Belgium.

Wayang kulit, wayang golek and wayang topeng. The Javanese clown Semar and his son Petruk, and little mouse-deer Kancil.

Turkish shadow puppets. The comical Karagöz and his friend Hacivat. Have fun. Applause!

















































































